

- 2. Mayor Armentrout** went over the August 2011 Maintenance report.
 - Replaced fire hydrant on Stebbins Drive
 - Repaired two water leaks on Erie Street
 - Open and closed (5) graves
 - Cleaned up Park for the Ox Roast and Car Show
 - Changed engine in 2005 Crown Vic
 - Flushed fire hydrants
 - Replaced more concrete in Crestview Dr.
 - Rt. 3 got repaired

- 3.** Mayor Armentrout informed Council that Ted Short from Rails to Trails contacted the Village to let us know that they would like to buy land that Ken @ the Creston Car Wash owns and then Rails to Trails will give the land to the Village of Creston. Ted Short will be at the October 2011 Council meeting to explain.

- 4.** Cm. Lyle Kalina announced that the Creston Historical Society would like to save the old depot that is now the Village's. The Historical Society would like to move it but has no money to do so. Jason Flory advised everyone that the Village will still use this building until it is approved to build a new building. Jason also offered to help move the building, but because of its condition Jason wouldn't guarantee how many pieces it would be in after the move.

- 5.** Mayor Armentrout advised Council that he wants meeting agendas turned in the Thursday before the committee meetings. There has been a problem with agendas not being turned in and then I have been at meetings where issues are brought up at the meeting that would require the Clerk Treasurer to have information ready. Pam cannot have information ready if she doesn't know what it is. Pam would be happy to have information ready but please contact her and give her ample time to gather the information needed. A brief discussion was held concerning who should submit the agenda to Pam. Mayor Armentrout advised committee members to contact their committee chairperson with anything they have and then the chairperson is to submit the agenda to Pam.

- 6.** Mayor Armentrout advised Council that in order to have our Village events on the Visitor Bureau's calendar we need to decide tonight on dates. Pam Hostetler stated that the Car Show will be on Sunday, September 2, 2012 and if Council wants to keep the Yard Sales on the same weekend, 1st. Thurs. Fri. and Sat. of June, 2012, that falls on Memorial Day weekend. The next weekend would be June 7, 8 & 9, 2012. A short discussion was held with Mayor Armentrout stating we don't need a motion for this, is anyone apposed to June 7, 8 & 9, 2012.

Cm. Keith Studer advised everyone that this is tabled as of now; you will have to go back to Finance.

Clerk Treasurer Pam Hostetler asked the Solicitor, when an issue is discussed by the sub-committee and recommended to Finance then tabled by Finance, can the same issue be brought back up over and over again at a Council meeting? Are we proceeding properly? The Solicitor replied yes, any issue that has been tabled can be brought back up by a Council member at a Council meeting.

Note from Clerk Treasurer Pam Hostetler: Rules of Council clearly states on page 5A that all business for transaction by the council must be in the Clerk's office no later than close of business the Thursday before the Council meeting on the Monday following. The Clerk may prepare a last minute addendum, which may be added to the agenda by an affirmation vote of the Council.

Cm. Marlin Hostettler-

1. We want to sell, if we don't want to put money in it let's sell it. Pam Hostetler asked Marlin to clarify, who are "we". Marlin replied Council. Pam asked Marlin to clarify, what does Council want to sell? Mayor Armentrout asked Marlin if he was making a motion to sell the Community Center. Marlin replied no, the parking lot, let's sell the parking lot. Marlin then yelled at Cm. Keith Studer and Cw. Gerry Mills for talking out loud to each other and interrupting him when he is trying to say something.

Note from Clerk Treasurer Pam Hostetler: At this point everyone was talking out of turn making it very difficult to hear what anyone was saying.

Mayor Armentrout then took control of the meeting by using his gavel.

The Solicitor explained that Council would have to go to bid in order to sell the parking lot with either an auction with advertising for five (5) weeks or list the property with a Realtor announcing that the property is going up for bids. You would need to make this very clear with the Realtor. Allan then continued to advise everyone that we would need a legal description.

Mayor Armentrout explained that Jason Flory is ready to do the catch basins in the parking lot. Council is who can't make up their mind. Jason stated that the price was \$6,662.00 after he took out the 57 limestone from the quote. That's been awhile ago and I don't know for sure if I can still do it for \$6,662.00.
