

VILLAGE OF CRESTON
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-34

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO MAKE INTRAFUND ADJUSTMENTS AS NECESSARY SUBJECT TO APPROPRIATED LIMITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer has historically received authorization from Council to make intrafund transfers to expedite the accounting of the Village eliminate the necessity for additional monthly legislation to approve intrafund transfers and;


WHEREAS, the Council for the Village still maintains oversight and approval of all expenditures and appropriations of the Village of Creston and;

WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary to continue authorizing the Fiscal Officer to have the authority to make necessary transfers within a fund subject to the appropriated limits and shall have the ability to revoke this authority at any time in the future with subsequent legislation.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. That the Fiscal Officer shall have the authority to make intrafund transfers subject to appropriated limits beginning January 1, 2023.
2. Council for the Village of Creston shall maintain authority to approve all appropriations and shall have the ability to repeal this Ordinance at any time and revoke the authorization given to the Fiscal Officer.
3. Council has reviewed the intrafund transfers for 2023 and has determined the transfers are appropriate and ratifies all intrafund transfers completed by the Fiscal Officer for 2023.
4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Creston and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency is to streamline the accounting for the Village. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
