

**VILLAGE OF CRESTON**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 2024-08**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 12-11 AND SETTING FORTH RENTAL RATES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, The Village of Creston owns certain buildings and property that are available for public rental;

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the prior rental rates and determined that it is necessary to update those rates due to an increase in the maintenance of the building and property; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

1. Effective March 5, 2024 rental rates for Murray Hall, Building 1, Building 2, the new Pavilion, Gazebo, and the Community Center shall be as follows:

Community Center:

\$75.00 Resident full day for Community Center  
\$100.00 Non-resident full day for Community Center  
There will be no half day rental or hourly rental.

Murray Hall:

\$60.00 Resident full day for Murray Hall  
\$85.00 Non-resident full day for Murray Hall

Pavilion 1, Pavilion 2:

\$25.00 Resident full day for Pavilion 1 & 2  
\$50.00 Non-residents' full day for Pavilion 1 & 2

New Pavilion and Gazebo


\$15.00 for Resident full day for New Pavilion and Gazebo  
\$25.00 for Non-resident full day for New Pavilion and Gazebo

There will be a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) deposit required for all persons renting any of the foregoing items which will be held until after the user's activity has concluded and an inspection of the same has been made by the Village. This requirement may be waived by the Village for service organizations.

2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.

3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Creston and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency is to have adequate agreement to protect Village property. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
