

**VILLAGE OF CRESTON**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 04-2024**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE SOLICITOR TO PETITION THE TAX COMMISSIONER FOR THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN FUNDS AND THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS REMAINING.**

WHEREAS, Council has been made aware there are funds in certain accounts that are no longer active; and

WHEREAS, these funds were set up as to pay for certain capital projects that have since been completed and paid in full; and

WHEREAS, Fund 4201 contains a residual fund balance of \$170,862.42; and

WHEREAS, Fund 4202 contains a residual fund balance of \$7,324.29; and

WHEREAS, Fund 4203 contains a residual fund balance of \$20,626.90; and

WHEREAS, Fund 4901 contains a residual fund balance of \$68,461.71; and


WHEREAS, no expenditures have been disbursed from any of these funds sine prior to the implementation of the current accounting system; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Sections 5705.15 and 5705.16 permits Village Council contingent upon the approval of from the Ohio Tax Commissioner, to authorize transfers of funds otherwise prohibited by Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.14

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

1. The Village Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to petition the Ohio Tax Commissioner for approval pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.16 to transfer the residual fund balances in Funds 4201, 4202, 4203, and 4901 to the General Fund 1000.
2. Contingent upon the approval by the Ohio Tax Commissioner of the petition, the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to execute the transfer of the residual fund balances in Funds 4201, 4202, 4203, and 4901 to the General Fund 1000.
3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
