**ORDINANCE NO. 2026-05**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON ZONING CODE SECTION 1115.15.**

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Village of Creston desires to update the Village’s Zoning Code Book to restore Zoning Code requirement of setbacks on fences to the prior language and;

**WHEREAS**, Council referred this matter to the Zoning and Planning Commission for their review and upon their review and public hearing the Zoning and Planning Commission recommends Council adopt this change.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

1. Section 1115.15 of the Village of Creston Zoning Code is hereby amended to add as follows:

Section 1115.15 (b)(5) Fences adjacent to private property must be located a minimum of three (3) feet from the property line. Fences may be placed less than three (3) feet of the property line with the written permission of the adjacent property owner.

Section 1115.15 (b)(6) Fences adjacent to a public right-of-way or alley must be located a minimum of one (1) foot from the public right-of-way.

2. The remainder of the Village of Creston Zoning Code not herein amended shall remain in full force and effect.
3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**VILLAGE OF CRESTON**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 2026-06**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AMENDING THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF THE TRAFFIC CODE TO LOWER THE SPEED LIMIT FROM 35 MILES PER HOUR TO 25 MILES PER HOUR ON STERLING STREET BETWEEN THE CORPORATION LIMIT LINE AND THE INTERSECTION AT STATE ROUTE 3.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village has consulted the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (“OMUTCD”) for various elements and;

**WHEREAS**, regarding speed limits the OMUTCD references Ohio Revised Code 4511.21, which establishes the statutory speed limits for local roads and dictates how they may be modified when the limits do not suit the current road and traffic conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code 4511.21 classifies a portion of Sterling Street as a “through highway,” assigning it a prima facie speed limit of 35 mph, although a portion of the roadway has a limit of 25 mph.

**WHEREAS**, the Village and the Police Department have reviewed and concurred with the lowering of the speed limit from 35 mph to 25 mph and consulted with the Wayne County Engineer regarding the adjustment; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance is in the best interest of the Village and its residents as it affects the travelling public and the life, health, and safety of the public

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:**

1. That the speed limit of the segment of Sterling Street between the corporation limit line and the intersection at State Route 3, is hereby amended from 35 mph to 25 mph.
2. The remainder of the ordinances and existing posted speed limits that were in effect prior to the effective date of this ordinance and that are not inconsistent or in conflict thereof remain in full force and effect.
3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
